## **Submission Requirements**

## Artist Eligibility

- 1. Artists 18 years old or older can submit to Canvas' 10<sup>th</sup> Year Art Auction. The artist may be in any phase of their career.
- 2. The artist must deliver the artwork to the Canvas office in person or via mail. All associated expenses are the responsibility of the artist.
- 3. Our charity focuses on supporting the 2SLGBTQ+ community and survivors of violence. We want to hear from artists who value our mission and identify as part of these communities. At no point are we asking artists to disclose this information.

## Artwork Eligibility

- 1. All artworks submitted to Canvas 10<sup>th</sup> Year Art Auction must be originals.
- 2. Artworks accepted include visual poetry, paintings, pastels, drawings, lino/etching/woodblock/silkscreen prints, photography, textile & fiber arts original artwork only.
- **3. Two-dimensional work must be ready to be displayed on tabletop easels.** If your art is not two-dimensional, we are asking artists to provide means to display their work.
- 4. All entries for Canvas' 10<sup>th</sup> Year Art Auction must be **submitted online** through their respective forms. Art submission forms sent through the mail will not be accepted.
- 5. Once submitted, artworks must not be altered or exchanged for another work.
- 6. Canvas reserves the right to decline any artwork that does not meet the requirements or is in poor condition (i.e. wet paint/ink, odor from the material on the surface of your artworks, fading from exposure from sunlight, cracks and tears from temperatures, humidity and mishandling, yellowing from paper-based artworks, mold and mildew from improper storage in damp environment, staining; accidental spills, exposure to liquids, or improper cleaning methods can cause stains on artworks, affecting their appearance and value,

loose or missing components; artworks with delicate or detachable elements, such as loose beads on a textile piece)

7. We are asking that the minimum fair market value of each piece is at minimum \$100 CAD.



## **Art Auction Details**

- 1. **Up to three works may be submitted for consideration**, but only one work may be accepted. Due to the limited venue space and submissions, not all artists will have a work selected.
- 2. Different sizes and price points are encouraged.
- **3.** Artworks must be no more than 18 inches in height and may not exceed 20 inches in width and no smaller than 3 inches in height and 3 inches in width.
- 4. Artwork may not weigh more than 8 pounds.
- 5. We are seeking Artists to donate 100% of the sale proceeds to Canvas. Artists will receive a donation receipt for their art's estimated fair market value.
- Artist who participates Canvas' 10<sup>th</sup> Year Art Auction will receive 2 tickets to Canvas' 10<sup>th</sup> Year and a 20% Discount code for Canvas' Corner Store

## Art Submission Form

- $\circ$  High-quality image of the artwork(s) you are submitting
  - Filename: LastName\_ArtworkTitle
  - Dimensions: 2000 x 2000 px or bigger (typically the full resolution of a smartphone camera photo)
  - File size: 10 MB or less
  - Accepted file formats: .jpg or .png
- Information about the artwork(s) you are submitting
  - Include the title, date created, medium, size, and fair market value (FMV). Please ensure the information you provide is accurate. It will be used to create the artwork's auction bidding listing, exhibition labels, as well as print and digital promotion during the Canvas Art Auction.

## • Artist biography

 An artist biography will be included in the online listings for Live and Silent Auction works. Your artist biography should be up to date and reflect your experience and background as an artist. You may also upload your CV if desired.
